

COVID-19 PROTOCOLS - Kingdom Indoor Center

MASKS REQUIRED (Ages 2 & 3 masks are optional)

PARTICIPANTS AND SPECTATORS MUST TAKE THEIR TEMPERATURE BEFORE ENTERING THE FACILITY. PARENTS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR MAKING SURE THEIR CHILD DOES NOT HAVE A FEVER AND IS HEALTHY. ANYONE WHO HAS A TEMPERATURE, IS SICK OR HAS BEEN POTENTIALLY EXPOSED TO SOMEONE WITH COVID SHOULD NOT COME TO KINGDOM INDOOR CENTER AND SHOULD FOLLOW LOCAL HEALTH DEPARTMENT GUIDELINES.

PLEASE FOLLOW TRAFFIC PATTERNS FOR THE FACILITY WHICH ARE HIGHLIGHTED ON FLOOR SIGNS. THIS INCLUDES PROPER ENTRY AND EXIT OF EACH FIELD.

CLASS PROTOCOL

- Parents must take their child's temperature each day before class to make sure their child is healthy to participate. Do not bring your child to class if they are sick or if they have been exposed to anyone who has been sick.
- Class participant must bring their own soccer ball. Players should sanitize their soccer ball before and after each class. Kingdom will NOT be able to provide soccer balls at class.
- Participants must bring their own water. No sharing. No water fountains available. It is encouraged that participants use hand sanitizer before and after class.
- Parents and participants should not crowd the check in area and adhere to 6' of social distancing.
- Participants must follow the designated entrance and exit from each playing area to keep a good flow and avoid bottle necks.
- There will be designated area for each player to keep their equipment and water bottle. On the boarded fields this will be the team bench areas. Parents cannot be on the benches.*
- Participants and Coaches must wear a mask during the class and at all times in the facility.
- Participants may have 2 guests. Guests must wear masks inside the facility.
- When training ends, the participants, coaches and guests must promptly exit the field and leave the facility adhering to social distancing.

LEAGUE PROTOCOL

- All participants must have a home temperature check prior to playing. Do not bring your child or yourself to the facility if any symptoms are present or if you have been exposed to anyone who is sick.
- Participants and Coaches must wear a mask during games and while on the bench.
- Player should NOT bring balls into Kingdom for league play.
- Players must bring their own water. No sharing. No water fountains available. It is encouraged that participants use hand sanitizer before and after game.
- Participants must follow the designated entrance and exit from each playing area to keep a good flow and avoid bottle necks.
- When on the bench, players should adhere to 6' of social distancing. No parents on bench area or field only coaches.
- Players should not physically contact teammates before or after games.
- Participants may have 2 guests. Guest must wear masks.
- No spitting, eating seeds or chewing gum.
- When games ends, the players, coaches and guests promptly exit the facility adhering to 6' social distancing.

KINGDOM SPORTS COMMITMENT

- Employees will wash and sanitize their hands continuously throughout their shifts.
- Employees will wear a mask at all times.
- We will conduct temperature checks on all staff and referees.
- We will properly sanitize the bench areas and alleviate overlap of customers.
- We will have separate entrance and exits for each field. Each field has hand sanitizer and it is encouraged that each person uses sanitizer prior to their game. There are sanitizing stations at the front doors as you exit the facility after the games also.
- Players will enter and exit the field following the signage in the facility and adhere to 6' of social distancing.

- Players should not physically contact teammates before or after games. Use verbal congratulations to show good sportsmanship after the game.
- We discourage spectators at this time but allow 2 per athlete.
- All participants are required to do the online waiver and online payment to assure a touchless system of payment due to COVID-19.
- We will not be providing any equipment so make sure your team has 2 color jersey options.
- Those customers not willing to follow guidelines will be asked to leave the facility.

CONFIRMED CASES

- If a customer or an employee exhibits COVID-19 symptoms, immediately self-quarantine and seek medical care.
- Inform Kingdom Indoor Center at chris@kicsports.net if you exhibit symptoms and are going to be tested. Immediately contact Kingdom Indoor Center with your test results.
- Kingdom Indoor Center maintains a list of teams (coaches, players, and officials) and employees present at each event along with contact information for each.
- Kingdom Staff will work with the local health department to identify potentially infected or exposed individuals to help facilitate effective contact tracing / notifications.
